REVISIONS AND UPDATES TO DOCUMENTATION AND DATA

1. Quinn, Robert P., Stanley E. Seashore and Thomas W. Mangione;
QUALITY OF EMPLOYMENT SURVEY, 1972-1973. (SSA 3510)

When the 1972-73/1977 Quality of Employment Panel Study was being prepared by staff of the Survey Research Center of the Institute for Social Research (The University of Michigan), a problem was discovered with 41 interviews conducted as part of the 1972-1973 Quality of Employment Survey. The problem was serious enough to warrant deletion of these interviews, and the cases corresponding to them have been removed from the ICPSR version of this data file. Users who received a version of these data prior to July, 1979, may reorder these data or delete from their copy of the file the cases whose identification numbers are listed below. Since the original (unweighted) N of 1,496 has been reduced to 1,455 by the removal of the 41 cases, the printed frequencies are no longer completely accurate, and should be used with caution.

2. U.S. Dept. of Commerce. Bureau of the Census;
EXPENDITURE AND EMPLOYMENT DATA FOR THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE
SYSTEM: ANNUAL FILES, 1971-1977. (ICPSR 7618)

The second version of 1977 has been released. Version two has the non-response weights merged into the weight variable and contains 12 additional revenue variables. This file has 8,044 cases and 133 variables. For a description of the survey and related publications, see pages 307-308 of the Guide to Resources and Services, 1978-1979.

Data for 1976 have been re-released in a second version due to a problem with the data. Persons who received these data prior to August 15, 1979 may reorder the 1976 data file.

3. UNESCO Institut fuer Sozialwissenschaften;
SOCIAL BASES OF WEST GERMAN POLITICS, 1953 (ZA 145--ICPSR 7104)

A problem with the OSIRIS data file for this study has been brought to the attention of the ICPSR staff. A new version of this file has been prepared and may be reordered by users who received the OSIRIS data file prior to July 1, 1979. Please note that the card-image version of the data was not affected.

New versions of the card-image data file and the codebook-listed-to-tape file have been prepared; persons who received these files prior to July 1, 1979, may reorder them. The OSIRIS version of the data file remains unaffected by this change.

Due to the discovery of technical problems with the 1973 file from this collection, a new version of each of the 1973 files has been prepared. Users who received the 1973 files before September 1, 1979, may reorder them. The 1965 files are not affected by these changes.

Data files in this study have been regenerated to correct an error discovered in them. These data will, upon request, be resupplied to persons who received them prior to July 1, 1979.

The OSIRIS dictionary for this collection was recently found to be defective, and has been corrected. Users who acquired this machine-readable dictionary file prior to July 1, 1979 may reorder the file. Neither of the data files (OSIRIS or card-image) were affected by this problem.

MINORITY GROUP CONFLICT. (ICPSR 5209)
 1. Data are shifted exactly 2 columns to the right, thus the codebook should be modified by adding 2 to each column number, e.g. country code should be column 3-5 not 1-3.
 2. One data card is out of order. The record beginning with 07901186522 should be moved to follow the next record: 07901186521, which is the first card of that case.

The description on page 109 of the Guide states that each part of the study contains nine files. The data have, however, been combined such that the U.S.S.R. data are in one file which contains all 386 cases; while the U.S. data are in two files, one containing the total 307 cases and one containing the 101 case subset.

We are beginning a new service for users which will provide up-to-date information on Consortium archival activities via computer networks. Starting with the current holdings and newest additions to the Criminal Justice Archive, an on-line catalog of data holdings will be placed on the Michigan Terminal System, for access over the Telenet computer network from most major U.S. cities. This represents an expansion of a conference established for criminal justice researchers and analysts as part of a project supported by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA). Over the coming year, it is our expectation that this service will be expanded to encompass all new archival holdings of the ICPSR, and eventually will contain references to the entire archive. This is part of a broader, long-term effort to facilitate member use of the archive through network access for on-line searches of the data holdings, submission of requests for data, and communication with the ICPSR staff.

This service will be provided on a charge basis, since not all members have local Telenet dial-in ports. To help you decide whether to subscribe to the service, an initial trial use of the system is being offered without charge, amounting to approximately one-half hour of use. This will allow you to experiment with access through one or two sign-ons to see if you would like to utilize such a service on a continuing basis. Beyond this trial period, we will need payment in some form such as purchase orders or personal checks. A \$25 account is estimated as being a sensible starting level, permitting timely checks of the system for several months.

If you are interested in using this service, please send me a letter. You will in turn be provided with the trial sign-on account and basic documentation on using the system. The materials will cover the use of the catalog of archival holdings (which will encompass the Criminal Justice Archive first), the conferencing and message system, and selection of the other services on the Michigan Terminal System.
