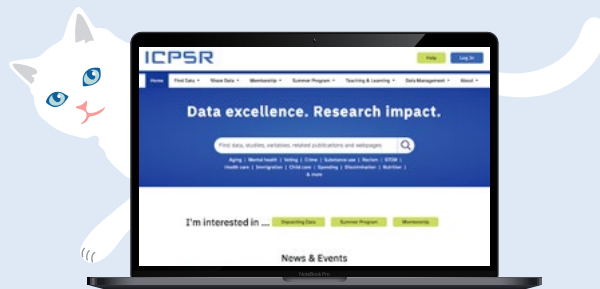

### College and Beyond II (CBII)

College and Beyond II (CBII) is a new data resource for studying the impact and outcomes of higher education. It contains student record and transcript data on bachelor's-seeking undergraduates enrolled from 2000-2021 at 19 public colleges across seven university systems. In total, CBII contains data on over 1 million students. These data are linked to qualitative data on course content, survey data on long-term life outcomes, National Student Clearinghouse data on educational attainment, and more. College and Beyond II was produced by a team of researchers from the University of Michigan and supported by a grant from The Mellon Foundation.

### Child and Family Data Archive

The Child and Family Data Archive (CFData) is the place to discover, access, and analyze data on early care, education, and families. CFData hosts datasets about young children, their families and communities, and the programs that serve them.



### Measures of Effective Teaching (MET) Project Series

The Measures of Effective Teaching (MET) Project was launched in 2009 to investigate how teacher evaluation methods can best be used to inform teachers about the skills that make them most effective and help districts identify great teaching. This project brought together 3,000 teacher volunteers in six different school districts with dozens of university and education organization experts and researchers.
