



Restricted-Use Data Management at ICPSR

Preserve the full analytic value of sensitive information through strict confidentiality safeguards.

Accessing data

Data dissemination methods:

- Secure dissemination: Encrypted data delivered by download.
- Virtual Data Enclave (VDE): Data stay on ICPSR servers; researchers analyze virtually. Analyses are reviewed for disclosure risk before results are transferred to researchers.
- Physical Data Enclave: Researchers analyze data at ICPSR building. Results reviewed for disclosure risk before release.

Researchers and their institutions must agree to the restricted-use terms; a data-protection plan and IRB documentation are typically required.

Depositing data

- Share sensitive data through our Secure Data Deposit process.
